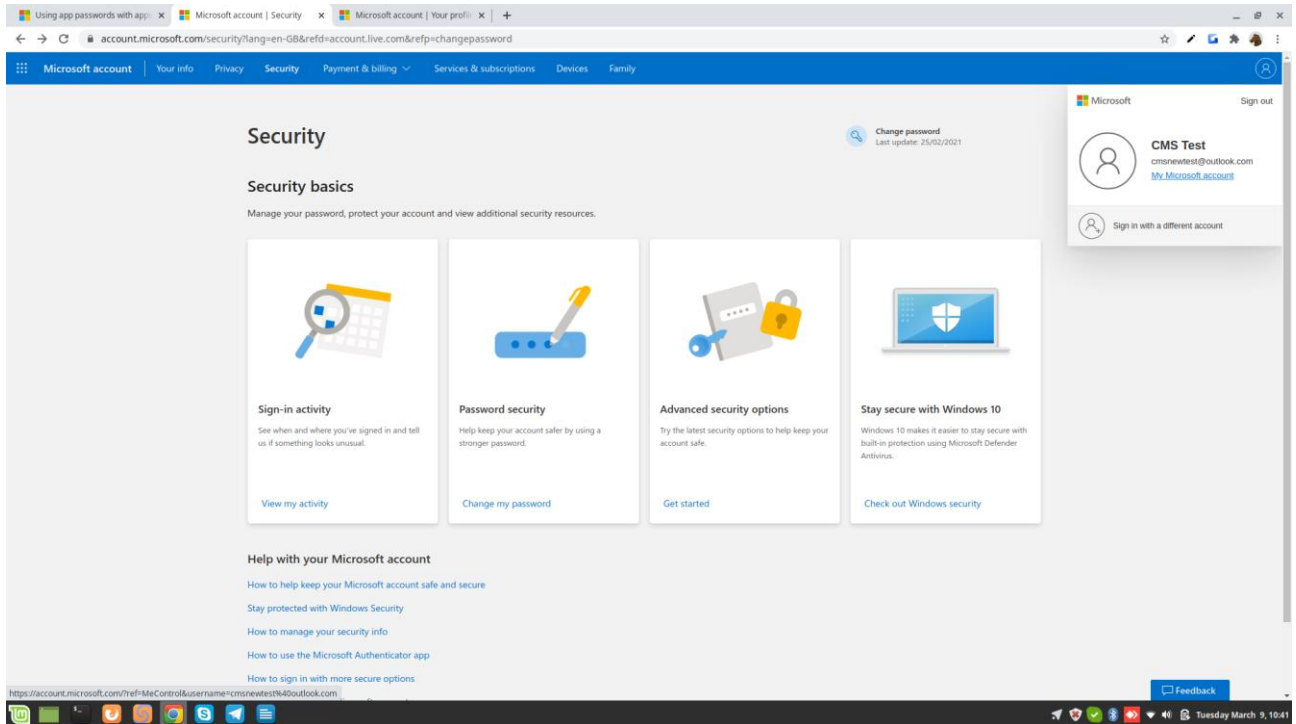
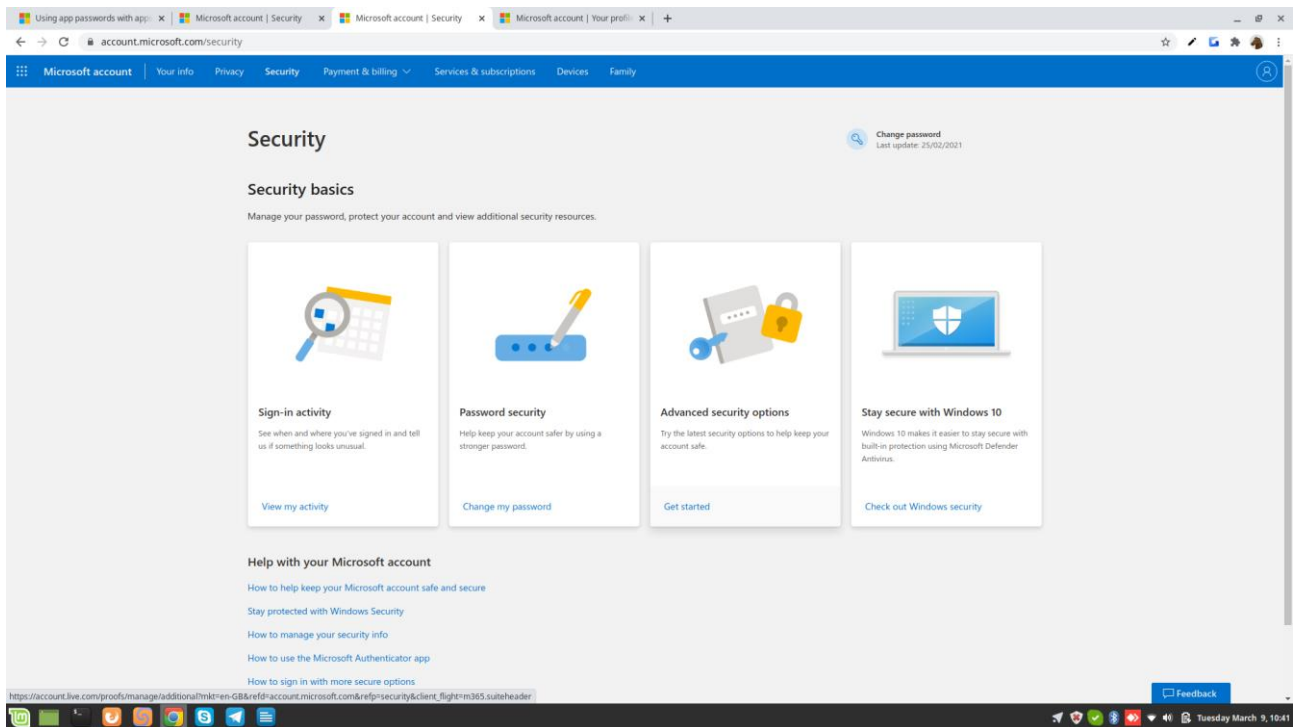

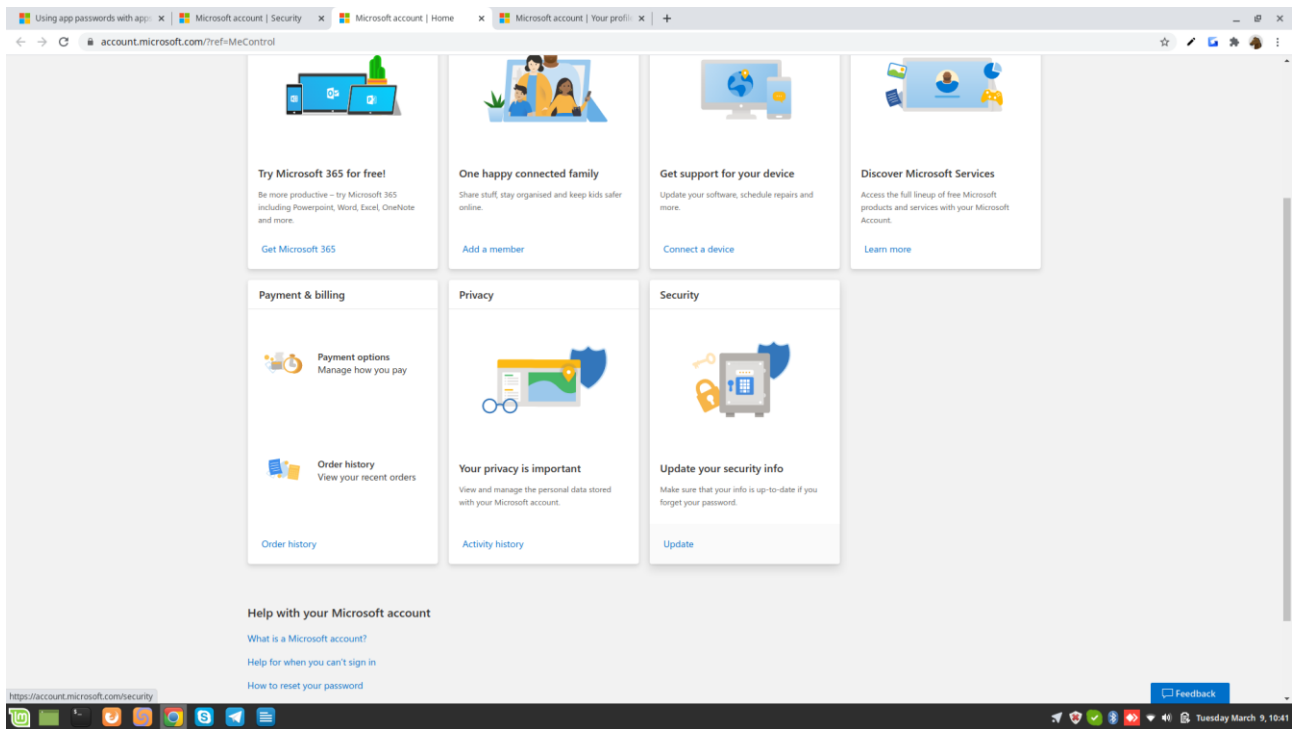
Step 1: Login into Microsoft account -> Click on My Microsoft Account



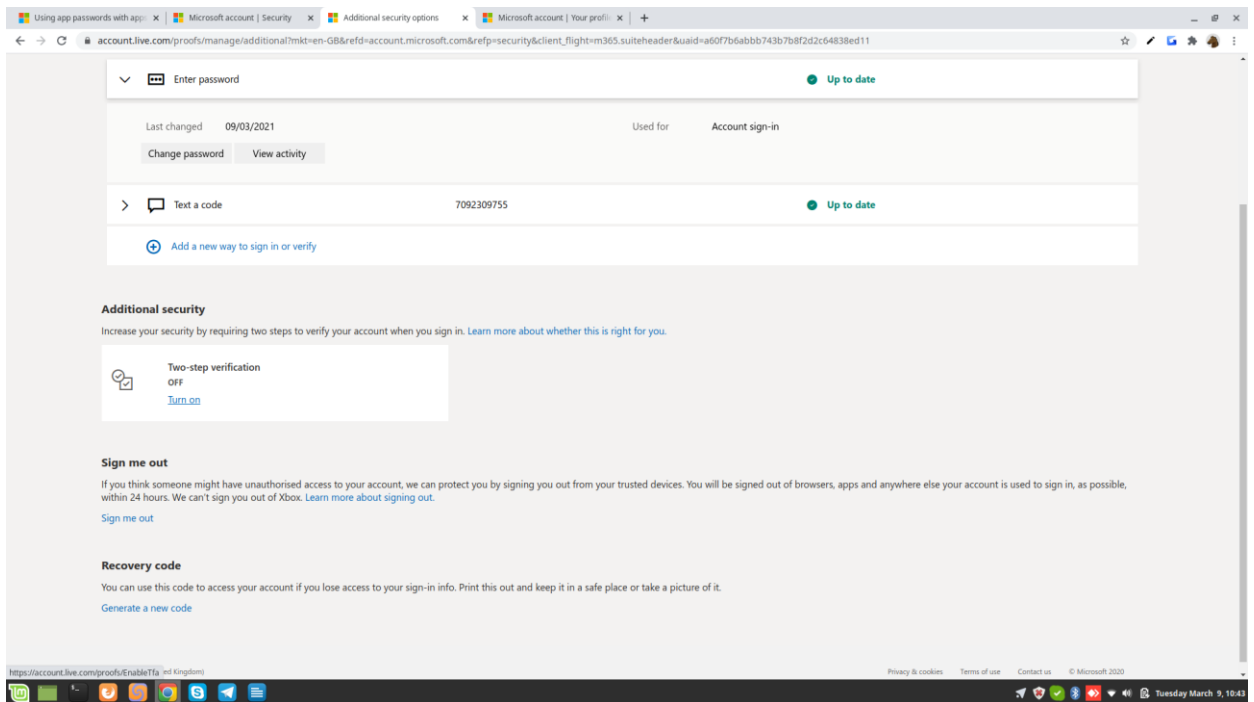
Step2: Click on Advanced security options-> Get started.

Set up two-step verification

Two-step verification adds an extra layer of protection to your account. After you've turned it on, we'll ask you to enter an additional security code when you sign in. We'll provide this security code to you only. In the following steps, we'll help you:

1. Make sure you have up-to-date security info where you can receive security codes.
2. Set up an authenticator app if you have a smartphone. (With an authenticator app, you can get security codes even if your phone isn't connected to a mobile network.)
3. Print or write down your recovery code.
4. Create app passwords for apps and devices (such as Xbox 360, Windows Phone 8 (or earlier) or email apps on your other devices) that don't support two-step verification codes.







Setting up your smart phone with an app password



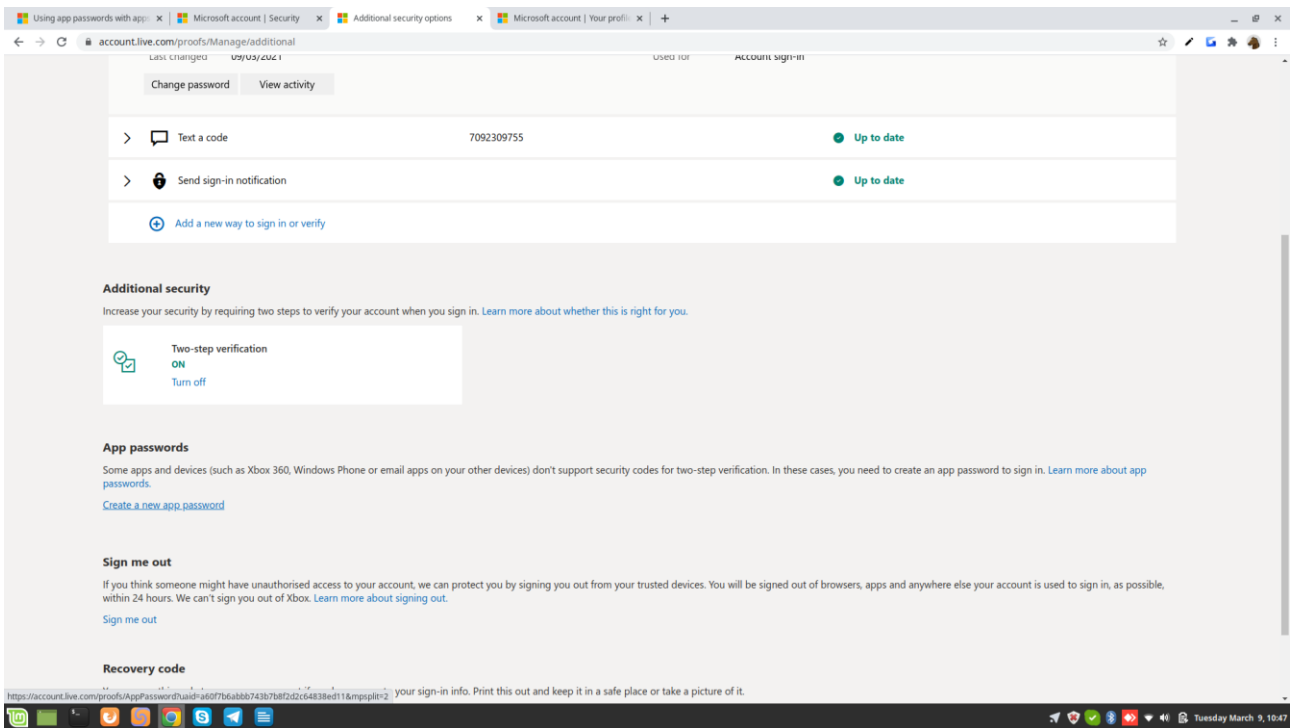

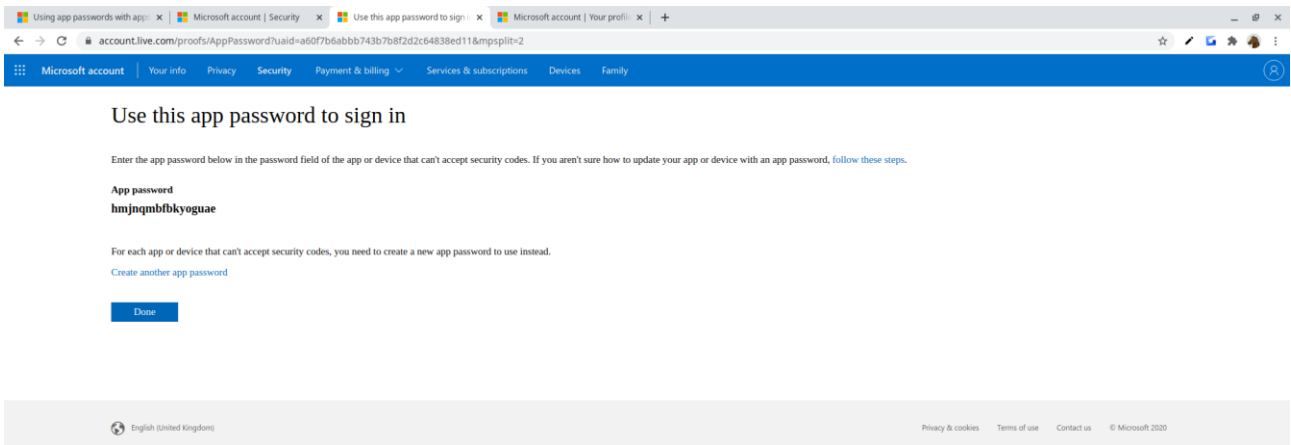


Step 7 : Create App Password credentials
