Dear Residents

As this term of Government approaches its end, we reflect on the work done over the past five years to develop Sembawang GRC. These are the combined efforts of the elected members, the Sembawang Town Council, community volunteers and the many government agencies we work with.

We have continued to upgrade infrastructure and amenities, while preserving the heritage and rustic charm of Sembawang GRC. As promised, Bukit Canberra opened with a hawker centre, Singapore's largest ActiveSG gym, swimming pools and a polyclinic. The Thomson-East Coast Line (TEL) expanded to connect residents to the city and the East Coast. The Woodlands Health Campus opened in December 2023 and the northern part of Singapore is now served by two general hospitals with capacity to meet healthcare needs for many years to come. The Home Improvement Program has started for our older blocks and will continue to be rolled out in the years to come. The waterfronts of Woodlands and Sembawang towns are now connected by a scenic 25km-long Northern Explorer Loop park connector. Initiatives like rooftop community gardens, Belanja-A-Meal and numerous activities organised by our grassroots organisations and Active Ageing Centres have brought the community closer together, and helped residents stay active and healthy.

Our pledge during the last election was to continue to Make Sembawang Special, and we hope we have done so. We have more exciting plans for the coming years, which we will present to residents soon.
