

Dear Residents,

2024 was a busy year for us, with many new exciting developments and new residents joining us in new precincts developed across Sembawang GRC. We warmly welcome all residents who moved in over the course of the last year.

The first quarter of 2025 has been a busy one in Sembawang GRC. We bade farewell to 2024 and welcomed the new year on a high note with Sembawang GRC New Year's Eve countdown. The turnout was fantastic, and all were in good spirits. At the stroke of midnight, fireworks lit up the sky to welcome 2025.

In January, we celebrated Pongal across the GRC, with many Indian residents marking the occasion in traditional ways — cooking Pongal (a mixture of rice and milk) until it overflowed from earthen pots, creating intricate kolams with rice flour, and enjoying vibrant singing and dancing. At the end of January, Chinese New Year festivities took centre stage. It was a month of feasting and togetherness as we welcomed the Year of the Snake. Each division celebrated in its own unique way, but the spirit of warmth and unity was felt throughout the community.

We launched our annual Bazar Raya Utara, with two locations, one in Sembawang Town and the other in Woodlands Town. Para Penduduk yang Dihormati,

Tahun 2024 adalah tahun yang penuh dengan perkembangan menarik dan kehadiran ramai penduduk baharu di kawasan-kawasan baharu di Sembawang GRC. Kami amat mengalualukan semua penduduk yang telah berpindah ke sini sepanjang tahun lalu.

Suku pertama tahun 2025 merupakan satu tempoh yang sibuk di GRC Sembawang. Kini, kita sudah hampir ke penghujung suku pertama tahun 2025. Saya yakin bahawa tahun 2025 akan menjadi tahun yang hebat buat kita semua!

Kita menutup tirai 2024 dan menyambut tahun baharu dengan penuh semangat sempena acara kiraan detik tahun baharu Sembawang GRC. Ramai penduduk menghadiri acara ini dan sambutannya sangat meriah. Tepat jam 12 tengah malam, langit diterangi dengan pertunjukan bunga api untuk mengalu-alukan tahun 2025.

Pada bulan Januari, kita menyambut perayaan tuai Pongal di seluruh GRC. Ramai penduduk kaum India meraikannya dengan cara tradisional — memasak pongal (juadah perayaan dibuat daripada beras dan susu) hingga melimpah dari periuk tanah liat, mencipta kolam yang cantik menggunakan tepung beras, serta menikmati nyanyian dan tarian yang penuh warna-warni. Anda boleh melihat gambar-gambar bagi sambutan meriah ini di halaman 6.

Di penghujung Januari pula, perayaan Tahun Baru Cina menjadi tumpuan utama. Ia membawa keceriaan kepada ribuan penduduk di estet kami. Pelbagai hidangan lazat dan kebersamaan serta kemesraan yang dinikmati sempena menyambut ketibaan Tahun Ular. Setiap kawasan telah meraikannya dengan cara yang unik, namun semangat keakraban dan perpaduan di kalangan penduduk tetap dirasai di seluruh komuniti.

Pada 2 Mac, bulan Ramadan telah bermula. Saya mengucapkan "Selamat Berpuasa" kepada semua penduduk Muslim kita yang memulakan ibadah puasa mereka. Kami juga telah melancarkan Bazar Raya Utara tahunan kami di dua lokasi, satu di Bandar Sembawang dan satu lagi di Bandar Woodlands. Bazar-bazar ini menawarkan pilihan makanan yang menarik serta persembahan tradisional untuk dinikmati oleh komuniti Muslim kami.

Terima kasih kepada semua penduduk dan rakan komuniti yang telah bersama kami serta memainkan peranan dalam menyumbang kepada kesejahteraan komuniti di ini. Bagi mereka yang berkemampuan, saya menggalakkan anda untuk turut serta dalam inisiatif-inisiatif dan usaha komuniti kami — sama ada sebagai peserta atau sukarelawan. Jadilah sebahagian daripada keluarga komuniti yang lebih besar dan Sayang Sembawang!

அன்பார்ந்த குடியிருப்பாளர்களே,

2024 ஒரு சிறந்த ஆண்டாக அமைந்தது. செம்பாவாங் பகுதியில் புதிய வளர்ச்சி திட்டங்கள் நடைமுறைக்கு வந்தன, மேலும் பல புதிய குடியிருப்பாளர்களும் நம்முடைய சமூகத்தில் இணைந்தனர். கடந்த வருடத்தில் செம்பாவாங் பகுதியில் குடியேறிய அனைவரையும் மனதார வரவேற்கிறோம்.
