Dear Residents,

As we draw near to the last quarter of 2025, I would like to share some exciting developments that will shape the future of both Sembawang and Woodlands Towns.

In Woodlands and Sembawang West, we have announced new Neighbourhood Renewal Programme (NRP) upgrades. These upgrades will bring refreshed facilities and enhanced communal spaces, making our estates more vibrant and comfortable for everyone. The Sembawang Town Council will work with the MPs in the responsible areas on implementing these programmes.

Looking ahead, the Rapid Transit System (RTS) is on track to open in 2027, making cross-border travel more seamless. Complementing this is the expansion of the Woodlands Checkpoint, which will grow to five times its current size. This transformation is part of broader efforts under the Johor-Singapore Special Economic Zone, further positioning Woodlands as a key regional centre with new opportunities for work, trade, and community life.

In both the towns, exciting concepts for new dining, shopping, and housing options are being studied, alongside plans to rejuvenate our waterfront. These efforts will bring fresh lifestyle and recreational choices for residents while preserving the unique character of our town.

On the national front, I had called for legislative changes to regulate KPods, including listing etomidate as a drug, so that tougher action can be taken against those who sell them, and mandatory treatment would apply for those who used them. Both the Ministry of Health and Ministry of Home Affairs have moved swiftly to list etomidate as a drug effective on 1 September. Pending these changes, many of our community centres took part in the “Bin the Vape” campaign, providing bins for those using bins to discard them before the stricter enforcement regime kicked in.

To all our residents celebrating Deepavali, I wish you and your families a joyful Festival of Lights filled with warmth, togetherness, and harmony.

Thank you for your support throughout the year. Here's wishing everyone a wonderful year end holiday season and happy 2026!

各位亲爱的居民朋友们，

2025年即将进入最后一个季度，在此与大家分享一些三巴旺和兀兰市镇即将迎来的令人振奋的新发展。

我们已宣布为兀兰及三巴旺西区推行邻里更新计划（Neighbourhood Renewal Programme, NRP）。这项升级工程将带来焕然一新的设施和更完善的公共空间，让我们的社区更具活力与舒适度。三巴旺市镇理事会将与相关选区议员携手落实这些计划。

展望未来，新马捷运系统（RTS）将按计划于2027年启用，使跨境出行更加顺畅。配合兀兰关卡的扩建工程（规模将扩大至现有五倍），这些转变都是柔新经济特区的重要规划，兀兰将发展成为集工作、商贸与社区生活于一体的区域核心枢纽。

两个市镇正在研究引入新颖的餐饮、购物和住宅概念，同时规划滨海区域活化项目。在保留市镇特色的同时，为居民提供更丰富的生活与休闲选择。

在全国层面，我此前呼吁立法管制电子烟产品，包括将依托咪酯（etomidate）列为受管制药物，以便对贩售者采取更严厉措施，并对使用者实施强制治疗。卫生部与内政部已迅速响应，自9月1日起正式将依托咪酯列为受管制药物。在新规生效前的过渡期，本区多个民众俱乐部参与丢弃电子烟（Bin the Vape）行动，设置回收箱供居民在严格执法前妥善处理电子烟。

在此祝愿欢庆屠妖节的居民朋友们，灯火佳节暖意融，阖家欢乐共祥和。

Penduduk yang dihormati,

Ketika kita semakin menghampiri suku terakhir tahun 2025, saya ingin berkongsi beberapa perkembangan menarik yang akan membentuk masa depan Bandar Sembawang dan Woodlands.

Di Woodlands dan Sembawang West, kami telah mengumumkan kerja naik taraf di bawah Program Pembaharuan Kejiranan (NRP). Kerja naik taraf ini akan membawa kemudahan yang diperbaharui serta ruang komuniti yang dipertingkatkan, menjadikan kawasan perumahan kita lebih meriah dan selesa untuk semua. Majlis Bandaran Sembawang akan bekerjasama dengan Anggota Parlimen(AP) di kawasan berkaitan bagi melaksanakan program ini.

Melangkah ke hadapan, Laluan Sistem Transit Laju (RTS Link) Johor Bahru-Singapura dijangka mula beroperasi pada tahun 2027, menjadikan perjalanan rentas sempadan lebih lancar. Melengkapinya pula ialah peluasan Pusat Pemeriksaan Woodlands, yang akan berkembang sehingga lima kali ganda daripada saiznya sekarang. Transformasi ini adalah sebahagian daripada usaha lebih luas di bawah Zon Ekonomi Khas Johor-Singapura(JS-SEZ), yang akan memperkukuh kedudukan Woodlands sebagai pusat serantau utama dengan peluang baharu dalam bidang pekerjaan, perdagangan, dan kehidupan bermasyarakat.

Di kedua-dua bandar ini, konsep menarik untuk pilihan tempat makan, membeli-belah, dan perumahan baharu sedang dikaji, seiring dengan rancangan untuk meremajakan kawasan tepi pantai kita. Usaha-usaha ini akan membawa pilihan gaya hidup dan rekreasi yang baharu kepada para penduduk sambil mengekalkan ciri unik bandar kita.

Di peringkat nasional, saya telah menggesa agar perubahan undang-undang dibuat untuk mengawal selia KPod, termasuk menyenaraikan etomidate sebagai dadah, supaya tindakan lebih tegas boleh diambil terhadap mereka yang menjualnya dan rawatan mandatori dapat dikenakan ke atas mereka yang menggunakannya. Kedua-dua Kementerian Kesihatan dan Kementerian Ehsan Dalam Negeri telah bertindak pantas dengan menyenaraikan etomidate sebagai dadah berkuat kuasa mulai 1 September.

Sementara menunggu perubahan ini dilaksanakan, banyak kelab masyarakat(CC) dan pusat rangkaian penduduk kita telah mengambil bahagian dalam daya usaha “Bin The Vape”, dengan menyediakan tong khas bagi membolehkan pengguna membuang peranti mereka sebelum penguatkuasaan yang lebih tegas dikuatkuasakan.

Kepada semua penduduk yang menyambut Deepavali, saya ucapkan kepada anda dan seisi keluarga Selamat Menyambut Perayaan Cahaya dengan penuh kegembiraan dan keceriaan — semoga ia dipenuhi dengan kehangatan, semangat kebersamaan, dan keharmonian.

2025 ஆம் ஆண்டின் கடைசி காலாண்டை நெருங்கி வரும் வேளையில், செம்பாவாங் மற்றும் உடலண்ட்ஸ் நகரங்களின் எதிர்காலத்தை வடிவமைக்கும் சில முக்கியமான முன்னேற்றங்களை உங்களுடன் பகிர்ந்து கொள்ள விரும்புகிறேன்.

உடலண்ட்ஸ் மற்றும் செம்பாவாங் மேற்கு பகுதிகளில், புதிய சுற்றுப்புற திட்ட மேம்பாடுகளை (NRP) நாங்கள் அறிவித்துள்ளோம்.

இந்த மேம்பாடுகள் புதுப்பிக்கப்பட்ட வசதிகளையும் மேம்படுத்தப்பட்ட பொது இடங்களையும் கொண்டு வரும். இதன் மூலம் நமது குடியிருப்புகள் அனைவருக்கும் சுறுசுறுப்பானதாகவும் வசதியாகவும் மாறும். இந்த மேம்பாட்டுத் திட்டங்களைச் செயல்படுத்த, செம்பாவாங் நகரச் சபை அந்தப் பகுதிக்குப் பொறுப்பான நாடாளுமன்ற உறுப்பினருடன் இணைந்து செயல்படும்.

விரைவுப் போக்குவரத்து அமைப்பு (RTS) 2027 ஆம் ஆண்டில் திறக்கப்படும் நிலையில் உள்ளது. இதனால் சிங்கப்பூரின் எல்லையைத் தாண்டும் பயணம் மேலும் எளிதாகும். இதற்கு துணையாக, உடலண்ட்ஸ் சோதனைச் சாவடியின் விரிவாக்கம் உள்ளது. இது தற்போதைய அளவை விட ஐந்து மடங்கு விரிவடைகிறது. இந்த மாற்றம் ஜோகூர்-சிங்கப்பூர் சிறப்புப் பொருளாதார மண்டலத்தின் ஒரு முக்கிய அங்கமாகும். இதன் மூலம் உடலண்ட்ஸ் வேலை, வர்த்தகம் மற்றும் சமூக வாழ்க்கைக்குப் புதிய வாய்ப்புகளுடன் கூடிய முக்கிய மையமாக உருவாகி வருகிறது.

இரண்டு நகரங்களிலும், புதிய உணவகங்கள், வணிக வளாகங்கள் மற்றும் குடியிருப்பு வாய்ப்புகளுக்கான சுவாரஸ்யமான யோசனைகள் ஆய்வு செய்யப்பட்டு வருகின்றன. இதனுடன் சேர்த்து, நமது நீர்கரைப்பகுதியை புத்துயிர் பெறச் செய்வதற்கான திட்டங்களும் முன்னெடுக்கப்படுகின்றன. இந்த முயற்சிகள், நமது நகரத்தின் தனித்துவத்தைப் பாதுகாக்கும் அதே வேளையில் குடியிருப்பாளர்களுக்கு புதிய வாழ்க்கை முறை மற்றும் பொழுதுபோக்கு தெரிவுகளை உருவாக்கும்.

தேசிய அளவில், KPodகளைக் கட்டுப்படுத்தும் சட்ட மாற்றங்களை நான் கோரியிருந்தேன். அதில் ‘எட்டோமைடேட்டை’ ஒரு போதைப்பொருளாக வகைப்படுத்துவதும் அடங்கும். இதனால் அவற்றை விற்பனை செய்பவர்கள் மீது கடுமையான நடவடிக்கை எடுக்க முடியும். மேலும் அவற்றைப் பயன்படுத்தியவர்களுக்குக் கட்டாயச் சிகிச்சை வழங்கவும் இயலும். சுகாதார அமைச்சகமும் உள்துறை அமைச்சகமும், செப்டம்பர் 1 முதல் எட்டோமைடேட்டை ஒரு போதைப்பொருளாகப் பட்டியலிட விரைவான நடவடிக்கை எடுத்துள்ளன. இந்த மாற்றங்கள் நடைமுறைக்கு வருவதற்கு முன்னர், நமது பல சமூக மையங்கள் “வேப் களைந்திடுவோம்” என்ற பிரச்சாரத்தில் பங்கேற்றன. இதில் கடுமையான விதிமுறைகள் தொடங்கப்படுவதற்கு முன்பே வேப்ப்களைப் பயன்படுத்துபவர்கள் அவற்றை அப்புறப்படுத்த ஊக்குவிக்கப்பட்டனர்.

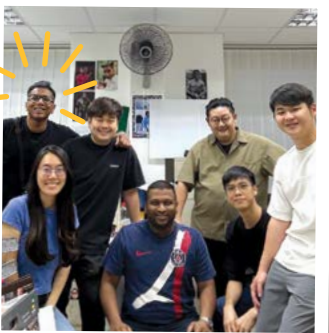
