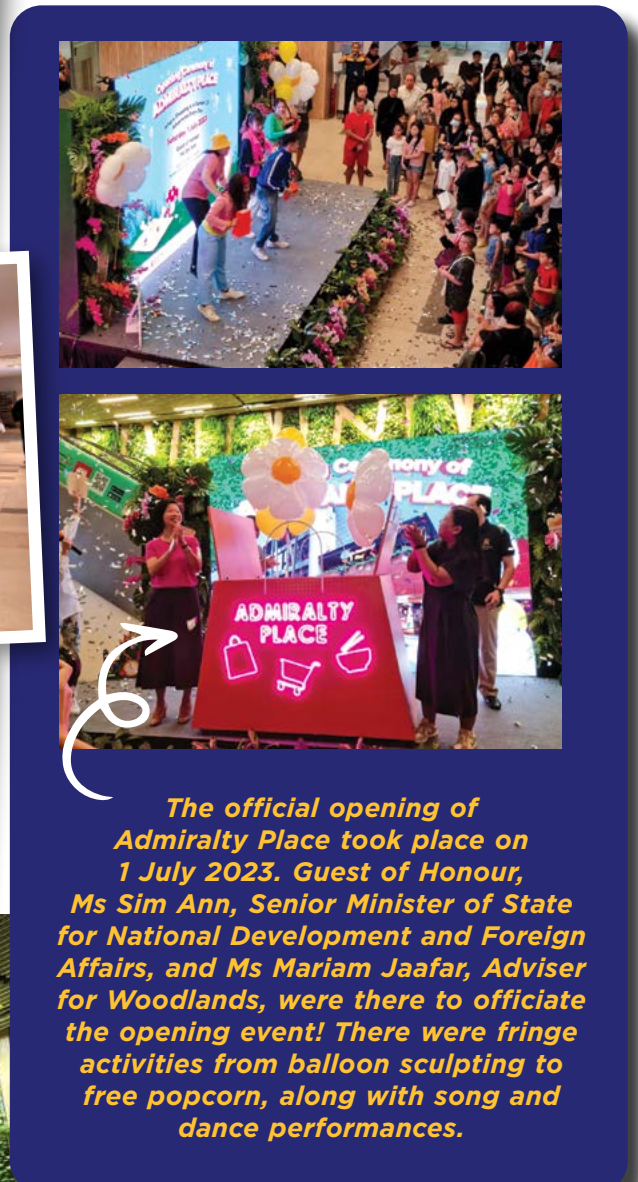
## A FRESH NEW LOOK AND SHOPPING EXPERIENCE

# SUSTAINABILITY DAY @ SEMBAWANG GRC

## *Walking Towards a Greener Future*



Throng of people arrived at the picturesque Sembawang Park on the morning of 16 April 2023, excited to participate in Sembawang GRC's first Sustainability Day. In celebration of Earth Day, residents, accompanied by eager children, and Advisers for Sembawang GRC Minister Ong Ye Kung, Dr Lim Wee Kiak, PBM, Mr Vikram Nair and Ms Poh Li San embarked on a journey of discovery and environmental stewardship.

The day kicked off with a 2 km walk on the Sembawang Nature Trail, which focuses on **reducing our carbon footprint**. Residents were divided into six groups, each led by representatives from NParks and student representatives from Republic Polytechnic's School of Applied Science. The representatives shared insights about the different trees and plants along the trail, conversing in both English and Mandarin. Notably, they highlighted the significance of the Macaranga trees, which symbolise healing of the forest and restoration of our precious nature reserves.

Following the nature walk, participants planted 100 native trees at Bukit Canberra and Canberra Park Connector under the MRT track. The community tree planting is in line with NParks' OneMillionTrees Movement and drives home the message of **protecting the environment**.

Residents then got to explore a plethora of sustainability-focused booths and workshops at the Bukit Canberra Hawker Centre. Here, residents learned about little steps they can take towards an environmentally friendly lifestyle such as proper recycling practices and ideas on how to turn trash into treasure. A Bloobox distribution further promoted recycling habits. Another key focus of the event is **food sustainability**. Microgreens starter kits and homegrown vegetables were available for purchase, empowering residents to cultivate their own food while supporting local produce.

Sustainability Day @ Sembawang GRC not only united the community but also reinforced the commitment to building a greener future. Together, let us pave the way for a more sustainable and harmonious living environment!

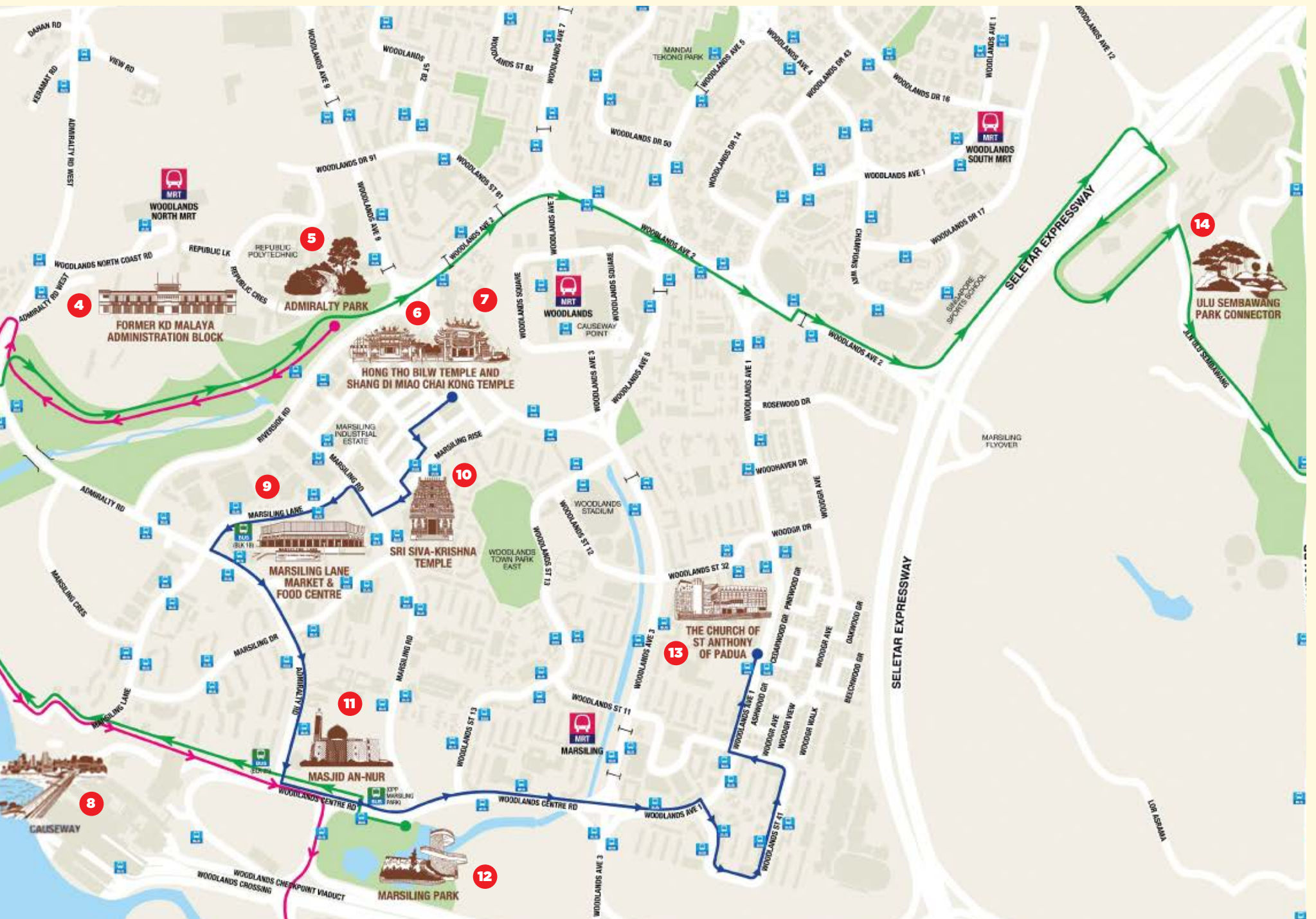

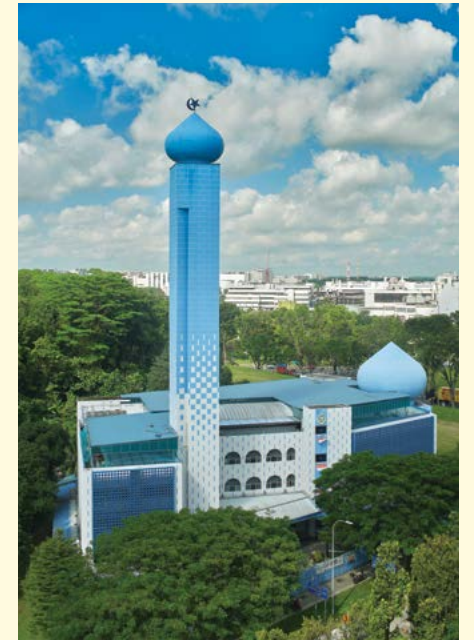

# AIDIL, RESIDENT PARA-ATHLETE

Meet Aidil, a wheelchair rugby and badminton para-athlete who has been a resident of Sembawang for the past decade.

In his younger days, he had a passion for sports, especially soccer. He also represented his secondary school in badminton competitions.

Aidil's life took an unexpected turn in 2013 when he was on the way to meet a friend for lunch. He was involved in a motorcycle accident which resulted in the loss of his left leg. It took him two years in rehab to recover from the accident, during which he battled depression. But he was able to overcome his depression after a month, especially with the support of his loved ones.

Seven years ago, his friend introduced him to wheelchair rugby, asking him to attend try-outs and that was when he fell in love with the sport. In early 2021, he was introduced to wheelchair badminton by an amputee support group, run by therapists at Tan Tock Seng Hospital. These sports introduced him to a world of camaraderie and

shared experiences with other disabled individuals.

Aidil cherishes the inclusive nature of these sports, where differences are celebrated rather than discriminated against. "It's an eye-opener for me because I can see different types of disabilities coming together as a team."

His advice to those with physical disabilities who want to try out a sport: "First you tell yourself that you have to come out of your comfort zone. Don't always tell yourself that you are in this alone, even if you have a different type of disability. Just don't give up and just come out of your comfort zone."

Aidil's journey is a testament to the power of resilience and the unbreakable human spirit. He hopes that Singapore Wheelchair Rugby will be part of the Para Games.

5. Wild plants/weeds ..... **1%**

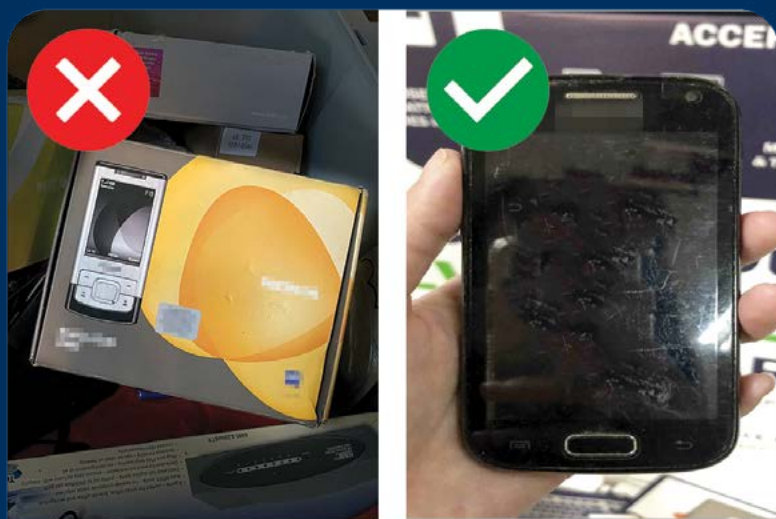

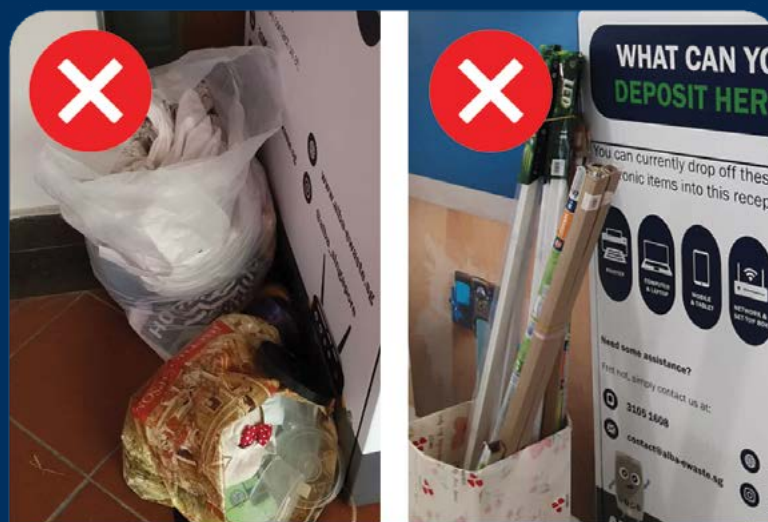
Remove all packaging (no cardboard boxes, no plastic bags) unless E-Waste is damaged



Secure all damaged E-Waste properly



Check what's accepted in each of the E-Bin types, and do not force your E-Waste into the bin if it does not fit
