11 new TEL Phase 3 stations opens!

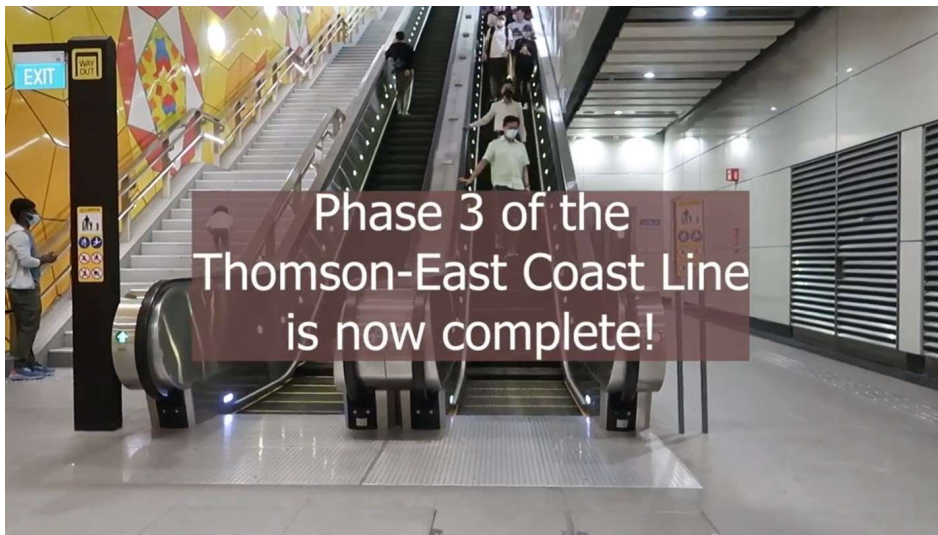

Grab Kitchen at Nordcom II

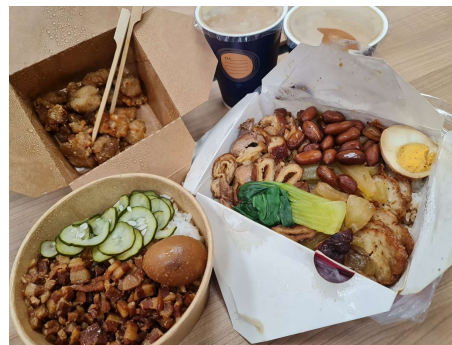
