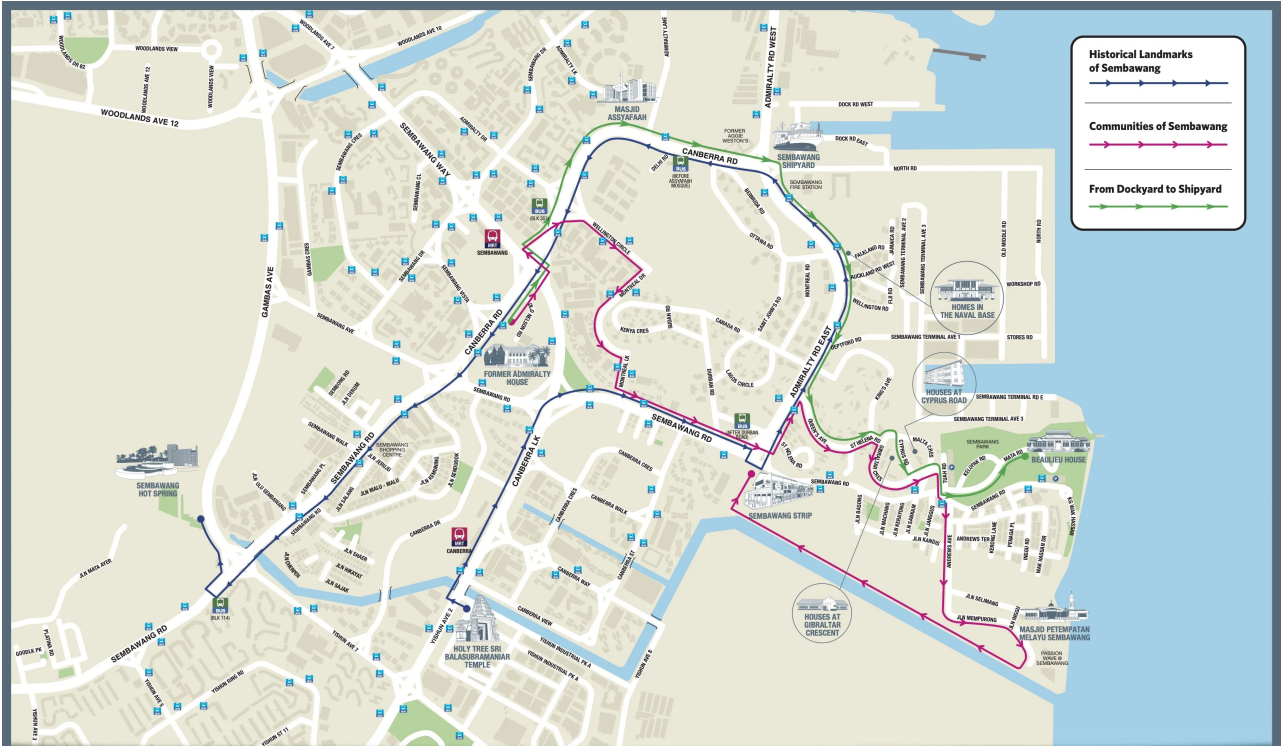

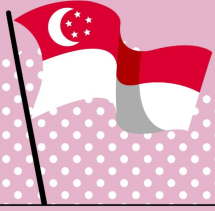

- ✓ **Do** fly with the stars and crescent on the top left-hand corner



⊘ **Don't** let the Flag touch the ground



⊘ **Don't** display where it might get damaged or dirty



⊘ **Don't** place objects over it
