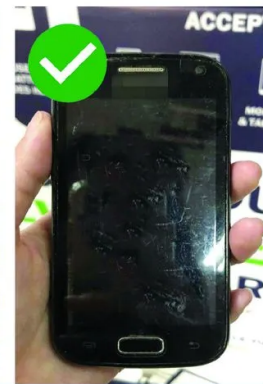


Tips on recycling your E-Waste correctly



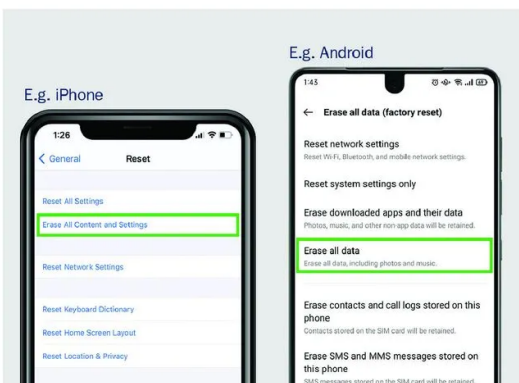
STEP 01

Depending on the E-Waste you want to dispose, check the location of the bins which accept it before making the trip down.



STEP 02

When disposing the E-Waste, do not dismantle the device (e.g. removing embedded batteries). Packaging such as cardboard boxes and plastic bags should be removed and placed in the blue recycling bins.



STEP 03

For any devices with data, if possible, reformat or wipe the data before recycling.




STEP 04

If the bin is full, dispose your E-Waste at another bin in the area or call our hotline at 3105 1608 for assistance.
