
Get excited, Sembawang GRC residents! What was formerly known as the Admiralty House will be transformed into Canberra House Library.

The library will revolve around the theme of nature, gardening, flora and fauna. Features of the upcoming library include café and reading areas, a children's tinkering space, lawn and spaces for community activities.

The Admiralty House was gazetted as a national monument in 2002. It was built in 1940 and was used to accommodate the Commodore Superintendent of the Royal Navy Dockyard.

New Features on Belanja-a-meal@Woodlands




Belanja-a-meal@Woodlands (BAM @ Woodlands) is an initiative to sponsor food for the needy with the help of donations from


people. There are now 2 new features live on the app where you can donate in cents and stall can now login to accept donations via an APP.
