



sentiment of fulfillment descended on the Woodlands Neighbourhood Renewal Programmme (NRP)
Completion Ceremony held at Block 852 Woodlands Street 83 on 6 October. It is certainly gratifying to witness wish lists of residents being transformed into reality under the NRP that spanned over 28 blocks and six multi-storey carparks at Woodlands Street 81, 82, and 83, as well as Woodlands Avenue 4.

"Three years ago, we had a consensus gathering. We took your feedback seriously and we delivered. Today, we have a street soccer court, a nice retro playground and Zodiac garden, and we are still making improvements to our neighbourhood," asserted Woodlands MP Mr Amrin Amin.

He was joined by Sembawang GRC MPs Minister Khaw Boon Wan, Minister Ong Ye Kung, Mr Vikram Nair, and Dr Lim Wee Kiak, PBM, as well as Vice-Chairman to Sembawang Citizens' Consultative Committee Ms Poh Li San. The MPs also planted Frangipani trees with bright red flowers to commemorate the NRP Completion Ceremony.



Other new and upgraded facilities were a new playground at Fu Shan Garden, upgraded courtyards at Blocks 824A, 826, and 827, a new drop-off porch at Block 868, high- and low-covered linkways at Blocks 839 and 883, new jogging tracks and fitness stations at Blocks 857, 858, and 864, a new sheltered badminton court at Block 851 and 852, and mural artworks at Block 852.

Mdm Yati, 51, who has a wheelchair-bound son, said: "Many barrierfree access facilities such as ramps, were built [18 in total]. Together with sheltered footpaths and linkways, it is now easier for my son to move around."

Mdm Siti Zulaiha, 28, was full of praise for the retro playground at Block 852. "The playground here stimulates a child's thinking and builds resilience, as he has to figure out the way to overcome obstacles to reach his destination. It demands intellectual agility as well as physical fitness," she observed.

Home-grown talents such as Singapore's Campus Superstar 3 finalist Ms Rachel Chua and Wang Weiliang, of Ah Boys to Men fame, charmed residents with their performances. Young children were also fascinated by wacky magic shows. The celebrative event ended on a high note with a sumptuous buffet treat for all residents.

BENEFITS 17,000 HOUSEHOLDS



Inspired by Sembawang's role as a naval base in the past, Canberra MRT station's exterior is designed like a ship. Gentle wave-like forms along the roof welcome incoming trains, while curved metal louvres not only mirror the appearance of a ship's hull, but also facilitate ventilation. Glass panels that line the sides of the station let natural light into the station. An art installation titled Symbiosis, by artist Ms Tan Zi Xi, features aquatic flora and fauna as well.

Canberra is the first MRT station to be awarded Platinum for the Building and Construction Authority's Green Mark for Transit Stations – the highest rating available. There are green features such as energy efficient air conditioning and lighting systems.

Residents dabbled in arts and crafts, balloon sculpting and games, and bonded with one another over savoury buffets at the opening ceremony.

"The new Canberra MRT station is very spacious, and I also like the rich diversity of marine life portrayed by the art installation. Now that I can just walk here and board the MRT train, I reckon I can save about 10 minutes of commuting time," said Ms Luu, 42.

While taking a stroll, look out for the information boards in the park and take the chance to educate the little ones on the history, floral and fauna of the park.




Amidst the lush greenery, visitors can also relax and take in all of nature's goodness at the naturalised stream.

FACTORY CAFE

Deriving its name from the industrial area in which it resides, Factory Cafe is a humble eatery with a hidden treasure trove of activities. Located on the second floor is Urban Tavern, an event space where visitors young and old can find something to keep them occupied for hours on end.

Think arcade games like air hockey, claw machines and basketball hoops, foosball and pool tables as well as a dart machine.

Keep in mind that the Urban Tavern activity area is by reservation only, which you can book online. The event space is open for rental 24/7, but Factory Cafe's operation hours are only till 3pm on weekdays, so swing by early if you're craving a solid meal plus affordable brews. 



Non-motorised PMDs, such as manual kickscooters, may continue to be used on footpaths.



With effect from 5 November 2019, be able to continue riding on these footpaths. However, riders will still available in GRC. e-scooters are not allowed on shared paths


