

SEMBAWANG HERITAGE TRAIL:

BRINGING FRESH PERSPECTIVES, REKINDLING FOND MEMORIES

eritage trails are interesting and informative endeavours to anchor social memories of past generations, while orienting new residents with curated heritage of the place they live, work and play. On 26 September 2021, MPs for Sembawang GRC, Minister Ong Ye Kung, Dr Lim Wee Kiak, PBM, Mr Vikram Nair, Ms Poh Li San and Ms Mariam Jaafar, came together with our residents to experience the recently launched Sembawang Heritage Trail.



Famous landmarks such as Sembawang Naval Base, Sembawang Shipyard and Sembawang Hot Spring Park are among the many heritage sites showcased in the three routes that make up the Sembawang Heritage Trail, spanning a total of 20 km. Trishaw rides were offered to residents as a one-off feature in Sembawang Park to evoke a nostalgic feel. Residents who volunteer to be heritage guides are partnering with community clubs to organise running, cycling and walking tours from October onwards.







"Our town is expanding and with many new residents moving in, this programme will serve as a bridge to bond and deepen friendships whilst enjoying our lush greenery. Many parts of Sembawang have retained the kampung feel and it is important for us to protect it for future generations to come," Dr Lim explained.

Veronica Ng, 55, who has lived in Sembawang for 20 years, has fond childhood memories, especially of the jetty. "When we were good, my father would bring us to see the ships. It's like a treat for us. And we were excited and started waving at the people on board the ships!" She also highlighted that it is important for youths to know their heritage and roots. "They should know how things have evolved, how it was like before, the history," Veronica said.

With travel plans derailed amid COVID-19, this is also a good time to explore our neighbourhood as we may not know everything about where we live. M. Avinaash, 14, a master trainer for heritage guides and a young volunteer of the Sembawang Heritage Trail shared, "There's actually a lot more than we think we already know. I highly encourage all of you to step out and discover."

Be Kind, Ride Safe IN SEMBAWANG WEST

Pedestrians and cyclists alike should feel safe along shared paths. Hopefully, this scenario will become commonplace with the launch of the Safe Cycling Campaign on 31 August 2021, in collaboration with Singapore Kindness Movement (SKM), Sembawang West Grassroots Residents' Networks, Safe Cycling Task Force (SCTF) and Sembawang Town Council. This initiative aims to promote safe riding habits amongst cyclists and foster a more gracious community in Sembawang West.

While plans are in the works to build additional cycling paths, MP for Sembawang West Ms Poh Li San acknowledged that it will take some time to catch up with infrastructure. "Instead of just waiting for the next few more years, let's do something that promotes the safe and considerate cycling culture, because I feel that you need both infrastructure and also considerate and safety-conscious cyclists to make it work," she explained.







Besides installing standees at blind spots and congested stretches to remind cyclists to slow down, give way and look out, lift stickers were pasted and drawstring bags distributed at the launch to remind cyclists and pedestrians to exercise care and consideration for one another. SCTF, together with the Land Transport Authority, have also stepped up on community corporate engagement efforts to educate workers in that area.

"Gracious riding is also about kindness. If you are gracious to somebody in front of you, you are not going to overtake in an unsafe way. You are being kind not only to the other person but also to yourself because accidents also kill you," Dr William Wan, General Secretary of SKM, espoused.

Grassroots volunteer Mr Shafiq Arifin, 29, felt strongly that more education will inculcate safe riding habits in cyclists. "I have spoken to some cyclists when distributing the drawstring bags. Some neither check blind spots when changing lanes nor know that it is mandatory to have front and rear lights on when cycling at night. If you are cycling in crowded places, do cycle at walking pace for the people around you to be safe," he advised.

his year, Sembawang West held its Neighbourhood Renewal Programme (NRP) Consensus Gathering via a webinar. It showcased proposed improvement works such as multi-generation playgrounds and fitness stations, revamped open spaces, landmark structures, wider footpaths and more. This will mainly benefit residents residing along Woodlands Avenue 6 and Drive 70.

Sembawang West residents will be thrilled to know that the NRP will proceed, as more than 80% of support was garnered from residents. Construction works will commence in August 2022, and is expected to be completed by March 2023.







As part of the Sembawang Town Council's team, not only does he ensure the cleanliness and upkeep of our Sembawang estates but he also shares a common goal of making Sembawang a green and sustainable town for our future generations. Meet Zheng Haw, as he shares with us why being sustainable is important and how we can contribute.

Q: Why is living sustainably important?

A: Sustainable living to me is a perception and a philosophy that emphasises the reduction of waste and limits the depletion of renewable and natural resources for our future generations to enjoy.

Q: How can we work towards a greener Sembawang?

A: We can start with ourselves. Simple gestures like using eco-bags when shopping for groceries and switching off the lights when they are not in use. Also, turn on the air conditioner only when necessary. These efforts help to reduce carbon emissions, which in turn also helps to ease the climate change situation that our planet Earth is facing. We have to support green efforts to sustain our world for better living.

Sembawang Town Council has collaborated with SembWaste Pte Ltd for many past green initiatives, such as the recycling drive that was recently held in Sembawang West. Meet Jaime, a member of the Sembcorp team, as she shares with us why we should adopt a sustainable lifestyle.



Q: What are some sustainable habits and efforts you feel strongly about?

A: Working in the waste industry, for me it is definitely the 3Rs — Reuse, Reduce, Recycle. Why do I feel so strongly about this is because in the context of Singapore and seeing how our waste is being disposed of, we don't have the space and allowance to accommodate the generation of large amounts of waste. All of the waste generated in Singapore are incinerated into ash and disposed into Semakau Landfill. Therefore, it is important to remind ourselves not to be complacent and the 3Rs are fundamental habits that help the core of sustainability in the waste industry in Singapore.

Q: How has living sustainably changed your life?

A: I think more often than not, living sustainably leads to some form of cost savings in your life. The most immediate example is reducing your energy consumption which will lead to a reduction in electricity bills.

Also, I think sustainability is not just about being more environmentally friendly, but it also involves social aspects as well. For me, living sustainably is also being more aware of how my actions will impact the next person. For example, if I choose to litter at my convenience, it would create extra work for the cleaners downstream. A little consideration from everyone goes a long way.

Q: How can we work towards a greener Sembawang?

A: I think small steps are significant in creating a big impact as a community. We can be more conscious of our own consumption and disposal habits. We can also educate ourselves and be informed on consumption topics like energy consumption, recycling, etc. We can start off by having more sustainability-focused conversations with family, peers and neighbours, so that we will have a collective goal and motivation.

LET'S TACKLE COVID-19 **TOGETHER!**

The number of COVID-19 cases has escalated in the last quarter. Sembawang Town Council has continued its intensified efforts on cleaning and sanitising our common areas, and also implemented new measures to ensure that our town remains safe for our residents. Here are some of the efforts we have taken.

- Playground facilities and fitness corners are disinfected once every 2 days.
- High-touch surfaces such as the inside and outside of lift cars, tables, chairs, and letter boxes are cleaned and sanitised at least twice a day.
 - *A special antimicrobial coating is applied to all lift buttons. With a single application, this protective coating is effective in controlling and rupturing the target organisms on surfaces for up to 90 days.
- New automated hand sanitiser dispensers are also installed at all lift lobbies in Sembawang GRC for residents' use.

We urge our residents to play your part by washing and sanitising your hands regularly, avoiding unnecessary contact with high-touch surfaces, and complying with safe distancing measures. Stay safe and healthy!







Have you received your free antigen rapid test (ART) kits and mouth gargle in your letter box?

- The Health Ministry conducted another round of distribution where every Singapore household will receive 10 ART COVID-19 self-test kits.
- Temasek Foundation has also distributed a 125 ml bottle of StayWell mouth gargle to all 1- to 4-room HDB flats via Singapore Post.
