NEIGHBOURHOOD RENEWAL PROGRAMME FOR WOODLANDS AVENUE 6 / WOODLANDS CIRCLE

The Neighbourhood Renewal Programme (NRP) aims to enhance your neighbourhood, making it safer, more accessible and more convenient for residents. The project is fully funded by the Government at no cost to residents.

This NRP exercise applies to residents living at Blocks 721 – 747, and 721A, 728A, 737A, 739A and 747A Multi-Storey Carparks along Woodlands Avenue 6 / Woodlands Circle.

Residents’ support is important for the project to proceed, and at least 75% of eligible households must vote in favour for the NRP to be implemented. If you are an eligible resident, we invite you to scan the QR code to cast your vote.

Need Help With Removing Bulky Items?

Our Town Council provides free bulky items removal service. Residents may call us for daily removal appointments at Tel: 63683100 from Mondays to Friday, 8 am to 5 pm.

Terms and Conditions Apply:

- This service is for HDB residents and not for commercial tenants.
- Removal can be carried out on a daily basis from Mondays to Saturdays, between 1 pm to 5 pm (depending on the location).
- Each appointment is limited to three movable items (E.g sofa chairs, television, refrigerator etc) per month.
- Additional items will be charged accordingly by the conservancy contractor.
- This service does not apply to residents moving homes, and does not include dismantling or removal of build-in furniture (E.g kitchen cabinets and wardrobes), renovation debris and Large furniture (E.g Pianō, Organ).
- Appointments must be made at least two working days in advance and are subject to availability.
